

The demonstrated organization chart represents the operational Procedures for Armed Forces to Assist the Local Government in Handling Disasters.

When a disaster handling application has been submitted to Armed Forces Reserve Command, a Central Emergency Operation Center and at least one Local Emergency Operation Center (including the liaison officer of Armed Forces Reserve Command) will be established. The affected disaster area(s) submits the application to the Local Emergency Operation Center (local center), and then the local center submits the application to the Central Emergency Operation Center (Central). Upon receiving the disaster handling application, the Central provides assistance to the local center, and the local center then provides assistance to the disaster area(s).

Meanwhile, the Central instruct the Joint Operations Command Center of the Ministry of National Defense regarding the disaster handling event, then it instructs Combat Command at all levels to instruct troops to involve in disaster rescue. The rescue troops will reply status to its Combat Command for it to reply to the Joint Operations Command Center and then reply to the Central.

However, local centers could also apply for assistance directly from the Combat Commands.
