

The demonstrated organization chart represents the four main offices in Armed Forces Reserve Command and their subordinate units. From the left to the right of the chart, the four main offices are Chief of Staff Office, Political Warfare Office, Internal Inspection Office and Directly Affiliated Units.

There are six subordinate units under Chief of Staff office, including Personnel Affairs Office, Operations Training Office, Logistics Office, Mobilization Management Office, Comptroller's Office and Rear Echelon Administration Service Office.

There are four subordinate units under Political Warfare Office, including General Political Warfare Section, Cultural and Psychological Warfare Section, Security Section and Military Dependents Service Section.

Three units under Internal Inspection Office, including Military Discipline and Ethics Section, Inspection and Principal Section, and Legal Affairs Section.

And there are six subordinate units under Directly Affiliated Units, including Headquarters, Medical Office, Reserve Mobilization Cadre Training Center, National Military Model Cemetery Management Section, National Revolution Martyr's Management Section, and Taoyuan Management Section.
