The demonstrated organization chart represents the organizational structure of reserve military training program.

The command office of the reserve military training program is the Armed Forces Reserve Command (also known as AFRC). The secondary command office is District Armed Forces Reserve Commands. And there are two committees reporting to District Armed Forces Reserve Commands, including District Development Committee and District Group Training Consultant. They are the third level of command of the training program management chain. And the fourth level is the County/City Reserve Command General Headquarters, including Kinmem and Lianjiang County Reserve Service Centers. However, the District Armed Forces Reserve Command will also directly supervise this level of commands as well. And the fifth level including County/City Development Committee and County/City Group Training Consultant.

And the sixth to ninth levels of this organization structure are Counseling Centers, Supervision Zone, Counseling Unit and the Counselor. Counseling centers are located in every city and are appointed one director, one deputy director and one secretary in service.

The next level is the Supervision Zone. Each Supervision Zone consists two to five counseling Units and is in charge of one supervisor. A Counseling Unit is set up in every village and in charge by a group of leaders. And finally, every one hundred to a hundred and fifty soldiers will be serviced by a counselor.
